Course Description: We are pleased to announce the 4th edition of our course entitled "Recent Advances in Oncologic Surgical Pathology". The course is organized by the Department of Anatomic Pathology, General Hospital, Udine (Italy) conjointly with the Department of Pathology, MD Anderson Cancer Center, Houston, Texas (USA) and shall provide the highest level of subspecialty instruction by a distinguished faculty recognized in the field of oncopathology. The educational event shall include 2 days of slide seminars and conferences addressing issues related to lung, breast, melanocytic and gastrointestinal tumors, highlighting diagnostic challenges, illustrating potential pitfalls and how to avoid them, and highlighting the role of complementary molecular techniques and their application in patient care.

Course faculty from the M.D. Anderson Cancer Center will include: Cesar A. Moran, Nour Sneige, Victor G. Prieto, and Dipen M. Maru. The inaugural lecture shall be delivered from professor Tullio Faraggiana, Department of Pathology, University "La Sapienza", Rome.

The greatest educational feedback is expected for community hospital pathologists, young practitioners and pathology residents. The course goal is to provide participants with practical and meaningful information relevant to diagnostic task, prognostic assessment and therapy guidance of cancer patients. Pathology sessions will be integrated by clinical satellite conferences held by a national faculty accomplished in pharmacogenetics and management of selected neoplasms. The course is intended for a broad audience; however, it is primarily designed for diagnosticians devoting most of their efforts to practical surgical pathology. Course organizers encourage the participation of anatomic pathology and oncology residents.

Location of the Course: The course will be held in Udine, Italy, a town of approximately 100,000 inhabitants in the center plain of the Friuli-Venezia Giulia region of northeast Italy. Udine is 95 kilometers south of Austria's alpine belt and about 50 kilometers north of the Adriatic sea tip. It can be reached via train (line track Venice to Austria), car (freeway Venice to Palmanova to Tarvisio, via A4-A23), or plane. Trieste International Airport is 40 kilometers away (freeway Airport - Palmanova - Udine, via A4-A23) and has daily flights from Rome and Milan; international flights from London, Munich, and several eastern European cities are also available. Nearby tourist spots include Venice (about 2 hours away by train) and Trieste (1 hour away by car, 1 to 1 and 1/2 hours away by train).

Course Venue: Hotel Lâ di Moret, Udine.

Official language: The course will be taught in English. Simultaneous translation services will not be available.

Continuing medical education credits: The congress has been accredited by the Ministry of Health as determined by the Ministerial Program of Continuing Medical Education for the following categories: Doctors and Biologists.
